STAR Search Survey

In 2000 very little was known about transportation options for seniors. For that reason, the Beverly Foundation invited the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety to partner in undertaking a STAR (Senior Transportation Action Response) program. Since that time, the Foundation has continued the program on an annual basis, and today it is the Beverly Foundation's primary research initiative, and the major data source on transportation options for older adults. The STAR Search database includes data on STPs (Supplemental Transportation Programs for seniors), volunteer driver programs, and volunteer drivers.

STAR Awards

The STAR Awards program was organized in 2000 in conjunction with the Foundation's STAR Search survey. Each organization that submits a STAR Search survey is eligible for a STAR Award. Since 2000, the Beverly Foundation has conveyed 24 STAR Awards for Excellence and 25 STAR Special Recognition Awards to STAR Search applicants from 24 states. Awards are made in two categories: STAR Awards for Excellence and STAR Special Recognition Awards. They have ranged from \$500 to \$10,000. Although every winner has expressed appreciation for the financial contribution associated with a STAR Award, many winners say...

The STAR Search Results

The first STAR Search survey was undertaken in partnership with the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety. However, national network organizations in the aging and faith communities offered to distribute the survey and information about it to their members. This process was so successful that it has provided the

model for the annual STAR Search process. 830 STPs (Supplemental Transportation Programs for Seniors) and 714 Volunteer Drivers have been identified in the STAR Search program. At least one STP is located in each of the 50 states. Products resulting from STAR Search data include: annual STAR Search reports; a 2000 and 2004 report produced in partnership with

the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety; an edited book based on the stories of volunteer drivers; an idea book for volunteer driver recruitment; a "how to" book for creating a state-based clearinghouse of STPs; and a workbook on how to organize a volunteer driver program. It should be mentioned that the surveys also produced a database on STPs, on volunteer driver programs, and on volunteer drivers.

Profile of Award Winners

The Beverly Foundation's annual STAR Awards program is an outgrowth of the STAR Search Survey. STAR Award winners are selected each year by a committee that includes experts in the fields of transportation and aging, and Beverly Foundation staff and trustees. Selection of STAR Award winners is based on criteria such as the 5 A's of Senior Friendliness (see Fact Sheet vol.1 (3)); service to senior passengers, special types of transportation assistance; community links, and sustainability. The Beverly Foundation provides funding for the Awards which have ranged from \$500 to \$10,000. Below is a profile of the winners of the 24 STAR Awards for Excellence and 25 STAR Special Recognition Awards.

A 2008 Pilot

In 2008, the Beverly Foundation undertook a pilot effort to streamline the STAR Search survey and STAR Awards process. The pilot included: (1) organization of the survey through the Beverly Foundation's web-based information initiative called the STP Exchange* ; (2) the development of a streamlined survey instrument; (3) the inclusion of a special question for use in judging "the best of the best" and in preparing technical materials; (4) the use of a web-based mechanism for collecting survey responses; and (5) the organization of a three tiered STAR Award selection process including: a first-cut staff review; a second-cut committee review; and a third-cut staff and Trustee final selection. 103 unduplicated surveys were submitted and \$50,000 in STAR Awards were made.

The three winners of the 2008 STAR Awards for Excellence and four winners of STAR Special Recognition Awards are included in the accompanying chart. Each winner of a STAR Award for Excellence received a \$10,000 contribution and each winner of a STAR Special Recognition Award received a \$5,000 contribution.

A Million Dollar STAR Awards Program

In 2009, the Beverly Foundation will initiate a Five-Year STAR Awards Program. The Foundation expects to make at least \$1,000,000 in awards between 2009 and 2013. Plans are to undertake a web-based STAR Search survey in the spring of each year. A STAR Awards review committee will be convened to review survey responses and to select award winners. Plans are to convey a total of \$200,000 - \$225,000 in STAR Awards each year. Award announcements will be made via news release to media outlets and the national aging and transportation networks; and awards will be
